Intended for:

Course content:

The syllabus is divided into 3 units:

Unit IGC1: Management of International Health and Safety

Unit GC2: Controlling Workplace Hazards

Unit GC3: Health and Safety Practical Application

The training will be taken within 10 days. Candidates are assessed by two-hour written examinations (for Units IGC1 & GC2) and a practical examination (for Unit GC3) which will assess their capability to put the learned knowledge into actual practice.
