About this course:

NEBOSH International Diploma is internationally recognized qualification aimed at occupational health and safety advisors and environmental consultants. There is no prerequisite for this qualification, but it is greatly recommended to have an extensive knowledge in the health and safety of the worksite. The International or National General Certificate training is advised.

Intended for:

The International Diploma is designed for occupational health and safety professionals, giving them the expertise to undertake a career as an internationally recognized health and safety practitioner.

Course content:

The course is divided into 4 Units:
